This second supplement (the "**Second Supplement**") constitutes a supplement to and must be read in conjunction with the base prospectus dated 21 November 2025 granted approval no. 25-452 on 21 November 2025 by the *Autorité des marchés financiers* (the "**AMF**") (the "**Base Prospectus**") as supplemented by the first supplement dated 9 March 2026 granted approval no. 26-051 on 9 March 2026 by the AMF (the "**First Supplement**") prepared by Carmila (the "**Issuer**") with respect to its outstanding Euro Medium Term Note Programme (the "**Programme**"). The Base Prospectus, as supplemented by the First Supplement and this Second Supplement, constitutes a base prospectus for the purpose of Regulation (EU) 2017/1129 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 14 June 2017 (as may be amended from time to time, the "**Prospectus Regulation**"). Terms defined in the Base Prospectus have the same meaning when used in this Second Supplement.

Application has been made to the AMF for approval of this Second Supplement in its capacity as competent authority pursuant to the Prospectus Regulation.

This Second Supplement has been prepared pursuant to Article 23 of the Prospectus Regulation for the purposes of (a) amending the "*Risk Factors*" section of the Base Prospectus, (b) incorporating by reference the Issuer's 2025 universal registration document, in the French language, which includes the audited consolidated financial statements of the Issuer for the year ended 31 December 2025, (c) updating the "*Description of the Issuer*" section of the Base Prospectus and (d) updating the "*General Information*" section of the Base Prospectus.

To the extent that there is any inconsistency between any statement in this Second Supplement and any other statement in or incorporated in the Base Prospectus, the statements in this Second Supplement will prevail.

Save as disclosed in this Second Supplement, there has been no other significant new factor, material mistake or inaccuracy relating to information included in the Base Prospectus which is capable of affecting the assessment of the Notes to be issued under the Programme since the publication of the Base Prospectus.

## RISK FACTORS

On pages 14 and 15 of the Base Prospectus, the sub-section entitled "*Factors that may affect the Issuer's ability to fulfil its obligations under Notes issued under the Programme*" shall be replaced in its entirety by the below sub-section:

### **"Factors that may affect the Issuer's ability to fulfil its obligations under Notes issued under the Programme**

In accordance with the EU Prospectus Regulation, Carmila updated the Group risk matrix in 2025, which incorporates the specific major risks to which it is exposed. These risks, selected according to their "gross" impact and likelihood, before taking into account risk management controls and policies – are nevertheless presented in the 2025 *Document d'enregistrement universel* in a matrix based on their estimated "net" impact, both in terms of impact and occurrence, after taking into account all of the measures taken by the Group to manage them along with any internal and external factors that mitigate the risks.

The risks that may affect the Issuer's ability to fulfil its obligations issued under the Programme are set out in particular on pages 81 to 94 of the 2025 *Document d'enregistrement universel* of the Issuer for the year ended 31 December 2025 incorporated by reference into this Base Prospectus, as set out in the section "Documents Incorporated by Reference" on pages 25 to 29 of this Base Prospectus. "6. Except as disclosed in the section "*Documents Incorporated by Reference*" of this Base Prospectus, neither the Issuer nor any of its Material Subsidiaries is or has been involved in any governmental, legal or arbitration proceedings (including any such proceedings which are pending or threatened of which the Issuer is aware) during the last 12 months preceding the date of this Base Prospectus which may have, or have had in the recent past, significant effects on the Issuer and/or the Group's financial position or profitability."
